

Expected Behaviours Policy

Purpose

This policy outlines the values and behaviours that all staff and students must adhere to at all times.

Values and Behaviours

In supporting the provision of a safe learning environment, the ACT German Language School expects all members of the school community to behave with respect and consideration for others. This includes:

- 1. Acting and working cooperatively with others;
- 2. Recognising that we learn at different rates and in different ways;
- 3. Respecting the learning needs of others;
- 4. Taking responsibility for your own learning;
- 5. Engaging in learning activities to the best of your ability;
- 6. Notifying your teacher wherever practical of a pending absence;
- 7. Notifying the ACT GLS of any accessibility or health issues that may affect participation with GLS activities;
- 8. Respecting the privacy of others and maintaining appropriate confidentiality of student and staff information;
- 9. Following any access and safety instructions for the learning venue, including bringing food or other materials onto the premises which may pose a risk to other learners;
- 10. Behaving in a way that does not pose a safety risk to yourself or others.

The committee, staff and volunteers demonstrate these behaviours and expect our students to respond in kind.

Review

This policy will be reviewed by the GLS' Management Committee, at least every three years, or more frequently in response to feedback or legislative changes.
